This application form is for **international students only**. U.S. citizens and permanent residents should apply online at www.ipfw.edu/admissions/.

To avoid any complications or delays with the admission process, please complete this application with information that matches your educational records and personal passport.

All international applicants must submit the following items before consideration for admission:

1. Completed International student application with a 50.00 USD non-refundable fee
2. Copy of passport photo page. Students already in the U.S. should also submit: Copy of visa and I-20
3. Proof of English proficiency. IPFW accepts the following official examination scores: TOEFL, IELTS, SAT, ACT, or completion of ELS Level 112.
4. Official Evaluation Report of educational records, transcripts, and diplomas: Students who have completed studies outside of the United States are required to submit a credential evaluation report. Credential evaluations provide IPFW with an official report that lists courses that you have taken and the grades/marks that you received with the U.S. equivalent number of credits earned and grade average.
NOTE: Academic documents that are sent directly to IPFW by the applicant will not be accepted to complete the application, nor can they be returned to the sender. IPFW works closely with [Educational Credential Evaluators](#), and we recommend their service. Please visit ece.org for specific information about submission requirements, service timelines, fees, etc.
5. [Certification of financial support](#). Usually, this is an official letter or and original statement from a bank, company, or government sponsor indicating the availability of sufficient funds to pay for your tuition and living expenses. The estimated cost of attendance for 2013-2014 is \$28,930 for undergraduate students and \$27,009 for graduate students (see [Estimated Cost of Attendance](#) [pdf] for details).
